On 20 May 2023 Barry and Bridget Hartman attended the funeral service and internment of Wolfgang Geckeler. Wolf passed on 30 April 2023. Wolf was my jeep driver in C Troop, 2-1 Cav at Ft Hood and in Vietnam 1967 to 1968. There were upwards of 200 at the funeral service in Galloway, NJ and many continued on to the internment in the Atlantic County Veterans Cemetery. The Service was very moving with appropriate eulogy by his son Jason and the military internment was done by the local honor guard. Wolfgang was sent to his final rest with the honors he deserved.

After his military service he returned to his trade as a Chef. Over the years he became a renowned chef, owner of several restaurants, eventually being awarded the "Golden Toque" in 2006, only 100 chefs in the US are so honored. Throughout his life Wolf championed many veteran organizations, and in his retirement, organized several soup kitchens in the Southern NJ Coastal Area. If there was a Veteran in need, Wolf was there to help. Over the years, we became great friends. He will be greatly missed.


